

GENERAL POLICY

- The Run of the Desert Charities 2019 will be held (rain or shine) at the Palm Desert Civic Center Park, 43900 San Pablo Ave. (corner of San Pablo and Fred Waring), in Palm Desert on Saturday, May 18, 2019.
- 2. The Run of the Desert Charities registration forms will be dated and time stamped as they are received. Spaces will be assigned on a first-come/first-served basis with a "balance" in mind when choosing within each vendor category.
- 3. There will be a \$25 processing fee on refunds. All entry fees are non-refundable after April 15, 2019. The event will not be canceled due to inclement weather. Please make checks payable to: MyCityEveryday Attention: Seth Cash, 74186 Santa Rosa Cir, Palm Desert, CA 92260. You may also email registration form to livewell@mycityeveryday.com Note: Emailed applications must include credit card payment.
- 4. All registration forms must include a description of what you will exhibit in order to be eligible for admission. Only displays that have been approved by The LiveWell Festival representatives will be allowed.
- 5. Official starting time for the Run of the Desert Charities is 8:00 a.m. Set-up time begins at 6:00 a.m. and must be completed by 8:00 a.m. Your space must be set up and operating no later than 8:00 a.m. All spaces must remain active until 1:00 p.m. Vendors who leave prior to 2:00 p.m. will not be invited to participate in future events.
- 6. The space contracted for is to be used solely for the name that appears on your contract and it is agreed that no portion will be sublet or used by any other organization or business.
- 7. The distribution of promotional literature must be limited to your assigned booth. Literature distribution in the parking area, restrooms, and festival floor is strictly prohibited. Exhibitors are only permitted to distribute literature advertising the company/category that is registered in the LiveWell Festival. Exhibitors that do not adhere to this policy will not be invited to participate in future events and may be asked to leave the premises.
- 8. For safety purposes, all participants must set up within the 10' x 10' or 20' x 10' space allotted to them. Areas between spaces may not be used as additional space or an added charge will be incurred. Only approved banners are allowed. Nothing can be stapled or nailed to the rental tables or surrounding foundations.
- 9. At an additional cost, spaces are available with electrical outlets on a first-come first-served basis. If you are requesting an electrical outlet, you need to bring your own extension cord.
- 10. All spaces must have adult supervision at all times. Experience has shown that adult participation is essential for an informative operation.
- 11. The MyCityEveryday and The City of Palm Desert will not assume responsibility for any damage, theft or loss of personal property or damage, theft to your space or loss of items offered for sale on the day of the Run of the Desert Charities.
- 12. All participants are responsible for cleaning up their space and surrounding area. Please remove all trash and other items used by your group.
- 13. Festival representatives reserve the right to close any space that is not being conducted in conformance with the rules or is not being managed properly.
